

**Governors Register of Business Interests
Full Governors Meeting - 23rd March 2017**

The Governing Body of Chewton Mendip Primary School, have agreed that all governors should declare any links they have with companies or organisations from which the school may wish to buy goods or services. It is important for anyone involved in spending money to demonstrate that they do not benefit personally from decisions that they make.

The Governing Body have defined a “pecuniary interest” as a situation where the person concerned, their family (immediate family, spouses, other relatives) or close friends have a connection with a potential supplier, or where there is any business connection (as employer, employee, or major shareholder). They should also declare if they have connections with any other educational establishments.
